allowed by the general oyster law, and such license shall be good for the entire oyster season."

Which was read a first time.

House bill entitled "An Act to regulate the shooting of squirrels in Howard county."

Mr. Long, from Select Committee, reported favorably, House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to establish a system for the collection of garbage in Hagerstown, Md."

Mr. Kendall, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal Act of 1896, chapter 193, and to authorize the County Commissioners of Kent county to provide for the building of a public school house in Chestertown, and to build the same, and to issue bonds to pay for the same, and to levy an annual sum to pay such bonds and the interest thereon as they mature, and for other purposes."
