Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide for an extra levy by the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, in Wicomico county for the purpose of refunding taxes erroneously paid in tax levies for the year 1897 and 1898, to pay the indebtedness of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, incurred by reason of the inability to collect the illegal levies of the said years 1896 and 1897, and to be designated as 'Section 158 A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Salisbury' and to follow section 118 of Article 23."
