Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to determine the status of typewriting."

Leave was granted to the Montgomery county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact with amendments section 190 and 192, of Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Rockville.'"

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Patapsco Investment Company."
