

## REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Choate, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 252, of the Acts of 1896, entitled an Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within half a mile of the junction of Gittings' avenue and Belona avenue in Baltimore county."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Hopkins, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to consolidate the corporations known as the 'Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church called the Eden Chapel, and the Wm. Waters Memorial Methodist' Episcopal Church of Harford county,' and to enlarge the powers of the consolidated corporation.'"

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Duncan, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 538, of Article 4, of Public Local Laws, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Inspectors, Weights and Measures,' sub-division 'Coal' as amended and re-enacted by chapter 123 of the Acts of 1898, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Inspections, Weights and Measures,' sub-division 'Coal' to follow section 539, to be known as 'Section 539 A.'"

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for the election to be held in Election District No. 5, or Queenstown district of Queen Anne county, to regulate the liquor traffic therein, and repealing section 193, of Article 18, of the
