Senate bill éatitled "An Act to require the County Commissioners of Talbot county to pay annually to the Commissioeers of St. Michael's a certain portion of tax levied or taxed upon the property within the limits of the town of St. Michael's."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Clark, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to the charter of the town of Tokoma Park, in Prince George's and Montgomery counties, as said charter was enacted by chapter 480, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, at its session of 1890, and amended by chapter 558, of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1894, and further amended by chapter 310, of the Acts of the Assembly of 1896."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Waller, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, paragraph 3, of section 61, of chapter 136, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the Session of 1896, entitled an Act to repeal from section 60 to section 77, both inclusive, of Article 23, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks,' and to repeal sections 61, 69 and 74, of said Article as amended by chapter 667, of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1892."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Clark, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery County, to levy a sum of money to refund to the heirs of Jacob Young, deceased, late of said county, certain taxes erroneously paid by them."
