Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to incorporate 'The Maryland Sanitary Refrigerating Ventilating and Heating Company."

On motion of Mr. Walbach,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Inspections to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 6, of Article 61, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Manures and Fertilizers,' as amended by chapter 397, of the Acts of 1894, and to re-enact same with amendments.'
