BY THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,

March 8th, 1900.

Gentlemen of the Senate:

We respectfully beg leave to recall the bill, Senate, No. 114, entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 351, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 67, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Disturbances of the Public Peace,' and to re-enact the same with amendments," said bill having been unfavorably reported by the Judiciary Committee of the House Delegates, and so returned to your Honorable Body on the date, March —, 1900.
