Mr. Knott, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably, with proposed amendments.

House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers, and amend the charter of the Union Bridge Banking company of Carroll county, Maryland, so as to enable in to loan money on or purchase promissory notes, bill obligatory or other evidences of debt."

#### AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amend by striking out the whole of "Section 2" and substitute the following:

"Sec. 2. And be it further enacted that the stockholders of said company shall be liable to the amount of their respective share or shares of stocks in said company for all its debts and liabilities upon note, bill or otherwise."

Sec. 3. And be it enacted that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Which was read a first time.

Amend by inserting in the 3d line of the title, after the word "company," the words "Frederick County, Maryland."
