Senate bill No. 117, entitled "An Act to repeal section 2, of chapter 310, of the Acts of Assembly of Maryland, of 1892, entitled 'An Act prescribing the regulations and conditions upon which the Board of Public Works shall sell the States' interest in all works of improvements,' as said section 2 was amended by chapter 172 of the Acts of 1896."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to regulate the keeping of the records and accounts in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Prince George's county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to extend and continue in force the terms of the Act of 1896, chapter 264, entitled 'An Act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the promotion of uniformity of legislation in the United States, and to authorize the appointment and continuance of commissioners thereunder.'"

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the commissioners of St. Michaels to borrow money on the credit of said town for the purpose of constructing water works and electric lights for said town, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said town, to redeem said bonds and pay the interest thereon."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Talbot county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill No. 170, entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Sharptown Marine Railway Company of Sharptown, Wicomico county, Maryland, a corporation duly incorporated under the general laws of this State."
