Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Senate bill No. 174, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact with amendments, section 24, of the charter of the Baltimore and Southern Railroad Company, as the same was enacted by the Act of 1896, chapter 271, so as to extend the time for the completion of said railroad."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Anne Arundel county delegation.

Senate bill No. 175, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the American Bonding and Trust Company of Baltimore city, and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 3, of chapter 252, of the Acts of 1894, incorporating said company under the name of the American Banking and Trust Company of Baltimore city, and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sub-section 2, of section 1, of chapter 41, of the Acts of 1896, amending the charter of said company, and changing its name to that of 'The American Bonding and Trust Company of Baltimore City,' and to increase the capital stock of said company, and to enlarge the powers of its officers."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sub-section L, of Article 20, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Somerset County,' sub-title 'Princess Anne,' as amended by sub-section 210 L, of the Acts of 1894, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
