Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal all existing laws for Somerset county relating to wild fowl and game birds and animals, and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof for the better protection and preservation of the same."

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to make valid the sales made and the deeds, devises and other instruments of writing executed and delivered by trustee or trustees to whom any estate, real, personal or mixed, shall have been limited or conveyed for the benefit of creditors, or to be sold for any other purpose where such trustee or trustees has failed to comply with the requirements of section 205, of Article 16, of the Maryland Code of Public General Laws, giving bond with but one surety."

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to fix, limit and determine the term of office of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, that shall be hereafter elected or appointed perpetuating the succession to same and repealing all laws or parts of laws, so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Queen Anne's county delegation.
