

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 201, of the Public Local Laws, Article 20, title 'Somerset County,' sub-title 'Princess Anne,' as amended by section 201, of chapter 543, of the laws of Maryland, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at the January session of the year 1894, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Waller, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 152, of Article 23, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Salisbury,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Collins from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the commissioners of St. Michaels to borrow money on the credit of said town for the purpose of constructing water works and electric lights for said town, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said town, to redeem said bonds and pay the interest thereon."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Smith from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to fix, limit and determine the term of office of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, that shall be hereafter elected or appointed, perpetuating the succession to same and repealing all laws or parts of laws, so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Waller, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide for an extra levy by the Mayor and Council of Salisbury in Wicomico county, for the purpose of refunding taxes erroneously paid in tax levies for the years 1897 and 1898, to pay the indebtedness of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, incurred by reason of the inability to collect the illegal levies of the said years 1896 and 1897, and to be designated as Section 158 A of the Code of Public Local Laws
