Mr. Collins, from Committee on Claims, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for a State subscription to Higgins' Laws of Maryland, relating to intoxicating liquors."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Knott, from Committee on Corporations, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the American Banking and Trust Company of Baltimore city, and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 3, of chapter 252, of the Acts of 1894, incorporating said company under the name of the American Banking and Trust Company of Baltimore city, and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sub-section 2, of section 1, of chapter 41, of the Acts of 1896, amending the charter of said company, and changing its name to that of 'The American Banking and Trust Company of Baltimore City,' and to increase the capital stock of said company, and to enlarge the powers of its officers."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Norris, of Carroll, from Committee on Hygiene, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 242, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Juries,' and to add an additional section thereto to be known as 'Section 242 A.'"
