House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 15 of Article 10, of the Code of Public General Laws, as amended by chapter 472, of the Acts of 1898, and to re-enact the same with amendment."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to extend and continue in force the terms of the Act of 1896, chapter 264, entitled an Act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the promotion of uniformity of Legislation in the United States, and to authorize the appointment and continuance of Commissioners thereunder."

Also, favorably, with request that same be committed to the Committee on Labor.

House bill entitled "An Act to add two additional sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' under the new sub-title 'Protection of Employees,' to come in after section 169, to be known as section 169 X and 169 Y, to forbid employers from restraining and preventing employees from joining labor organizations, and provide a penalty for violation thereof."
