The minority report was then considered, and

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message :

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 137 to 142, both inclusive, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' and to add new sections to said Article, to be designated as 'Sections 142 A, 142 B, 142 C and 142 D,' and to repeal chapter 597, of Acts of 1890, entitled 'An Act to confer additional jurisdiction upon Justices of the Peace of Baltimore county, and to repeal chapter 496, of the Acts of 1892, entitled 'An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 3, of chapter 597, passed at Jannary Session 1898, entitled 'An Act to confer additional jurisdiction upon Justices of the Peace of Baltimore county.'"

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as amended."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' by inserting after section 139, under a new sub-title to be designated 'Fees of Officers,' certain additional sections, to be known as '139 A and 139 B,' regulating certain fees to be paid to the sheriff of Frederick county, and to the county constables of said county."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Frederick county delegation.
