Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to refund to George W. Hatchenson, of Kent county, in the State of Maryland, the sum of \$40.94, for money paid by him in error for State taxes for twenty years from the year 1877 to the year 1896, inclusive, on private securities, which securities were improperly assessed, being paid before January 1st, 1877."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

Also,

Senate bill No. 149, entitled "An Act to regulate electrical wiring and installation in the State of Maryland, and to prevent incompetent persons from engaging therein, and to provide for the appointment of a commission to supervise and enforce the provisions hereof."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Also,

Senate bill No. 139, entitled "An Act to authorize the Queen Anne's Railroad Company of Maryland and Delaware to change its corporate name and granting certain additional powers and franchises to said company."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add two new sections to Article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Alleghany County,' sub-title 'Jurors,' providing for the selection and drawing of jurors in said county, said sections to follow section 178, and to be designated as 'Sections 178 A and B. '"

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Alleghany county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add three additional
