255 and 556, of Article 13, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Harford County,' sub-title 'State's Attorney,' and to enact in lieu thereof the following sections, to be known as 'Sections 254 and 255.'"

Which was read a first time.

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message:

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 296, of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Process,' as amended by the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1892, chapter 60, and re-enact same with amendment."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize, empower and direct the President and Commissioners of Princess Anne to issue coupon bonds, and to appropriate the proceeds arising from the sale thereof towards providing additional protection and apparatus for the protection of the property in the town of Princess Anne against damage and destruction by fire, and for the public convenience and accommodation of the inhabitants of said town, and towards providing, establishing and maintaining a system of sewerage for the benefit of said town and said inhabitants thereof."

Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city, to pension Andrea P. Caldwell, formerly a policeman and clerk of Police Board of Baltimore city."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.
