Mr. Anderson, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 49 and 56, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Worcester County,' sub-title 'Birds and Game,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to prevent the extermination of game in Worcester county."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Contee, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to give the consent of the State to the purchase of a lot or lots of ground in Laurel, Prince George's county, Maryland, by the United States of America for the purpose of erecting thereon a public building, and to cede to the United States of America, jurisdiction over the same."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Scrimger moved that

House bills, File Nos. 557, 650, 615, 511, 401, 559, 449, be recommitted to the Baltimore city delegation in order that they may be incorporated in one bill.
