in the last will and testament of John Coulter, late of Baltimore county, deceased, and the codicil thereto, and also to the bequests made by and contained in the last will and testament and codicil thereto of Eliza Jane Coulter, late of Baltimore county, deceased, and ratifying and confirming the said bequests in the will of said John Coulter to the seminary at Pittsburg, Pennsylvania, which is under the charge and control of the Reformed Presbyterian Church of North America, and to the Boards of Foreign and Home Missions of said church, and also to the congregation established in Baltimore, Maryland, of the said church."

Leave was granted to the Harford county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 651, of the Acts of 1890, entitled 'An Act to amend Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws,' entitled 'Harford County,' by adding additional sections thereto."
