Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Manchester Bank of Carroll county, Maryland, so as to enable it to loan money on or purchase promissory and negotiable notes, bills obligatory or other evidences of debt."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for a State subscription to Higgins' Laws of Maryland relating to intoxicating liquors."
