Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous liquors or lager beer at any place in Carroll county within one and one-half miles of Bethel Church of God, near Carrollton, Carroll county, Maryland."

House bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devises contained in the last will and testament of William F. Hooper, late of Wicomico county."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 448 of the Acts of 1898, chapter 123, entitled 'City of Baltimore--Charter,' and to re-enact said section 448 under the head of 'Fire Department,' with amendments so as to read as follows."
