Senate bill No. 27, entitled "An Act to repeal section 21, of chapter 323, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session, 1860, entitled an Act to incorporate a company to build a turnpike road from the Georgetown turnpike to the public road leading from Adamstown to Greenfield Mills, and to reenact said section with amendments, so as to read as follows."
