House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in the village of New Midway, Frederick county, Maryland, or within one mile thereof."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Rohrback, Betts and Ravenscroft.

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 93 and 95 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Prince George County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas as nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Peter, Williams, of Anne Arundel, and Gray.

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' to follow section 182, and to be designated 'Section 182 A.'"
