FURTHER AMENDMENT PROPOSED

In the 4th section, on lines 29, 30 and 31, amend by striking out the words following:

"As may be determined upon by agreement between the Columbia Telephone and Telegraph Company and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore," and insert in lieu thereof the following: "As may be prescribed by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city."
