

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Crothers,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 119, of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Cecil County,' sub-title 'County Treasurer,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Crothers, Williams, of Anne Arundel, and Moore.

By Mr. Crothers.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 420, of the Acts of 1894, entitled 'An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, chapter 470, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January session 1892, entitled 'An Act to promote, encourage and foster agriculture in the State, and to appropriate a sum of money therefor.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. Bryan,

A bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city, to increase the pension of William T. Lemmon, a retired patrolman of the Police Force of Baltimore city."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Bryan, Moses and Putzel.

By Mr. Williams, of Anne Arundel,

A bill entitled "An Act to provide for the paving of the driveway around State Circle and certain streets surrounding the Executive Mansion in the City of Annapolis, by the State of Maryland, and the Mayor, Counsellor and Aldermen, of the City of Annapolis."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. Dodson, (by request),

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 7 and 12, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of 1886, chapter 309, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the International Trust Company of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments.'"
