

Brooke avenue in Read's addition to said city, and the extension of said Fayette street, commonly known as Sulphur Spring Hollow Road, to its inter-section with the old National pike or Green street extending in said city, and to provide for the grading, paving or macadamizing, sewerage and otherwise improving said Fayette street and the extension of the same, commonly known as 'Sulphur Spring Hollow Road,' within the proposed extended corporate limits, and to provide for the payment of the costs of said improvement."

Which was read the second time.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Alleghany County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' to follow section 182, and to be designated 'Section 182 A.'"

Which report was adopted.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Alleghany County,' under the sub-title 'Taxes,' to follow section 230 of said Article, and to be numbered 'Section 230 A.'"

Which was read the second time.

Also unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 211, 212, 213, 214, 215 and 216 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Alleghany County,' sub-title 'Roads,' and to re-enact said sections 211, 212, 213 and 214 with amendments."

Which report was adopted.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Alleghany County,' sub-title 'Intoxicating Liquors,' to follow section 175 B, and to be designated as 'Section 175 BB.'"
