

the right herein granted upon any pretext whatever, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall, for each and every offense, pay a fine not exceeding the sum of \$500; and be imprisoned in jail for a period not exceeding six months, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Which amendment was adopted.
