## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 43, line 12 of engrossed bill, strike out all after the word "ground" to the words "the collector" on line 21, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"And to properly describe said property, the city surveyor shall actually survey and furnish to the city collector a description and plat of each lot so in arrear, and the sum to be paid for each survey including the description and plat shall be three dollars and fifty cents, said sum to be added to the tax bill and collected in the same manner as the bill itself."
