House bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Testamentary Law,' by adding a new sub-section to said Article under the title 'Fees and Estates under \$500,' said section to follow section 80 of said Article, and to be designated as 'Section 80 A.'"
