Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to add two additional sections to Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled 'Testamentary Law,' to provide for payment of decedent's wages without administration and be arranged under the head 'Administration,' in said Article."

Which was referred to Senators Bryan, Moses and Putzel.

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 51 B, 51 C and 51 D, of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' and re-enact the same with amendments."
