AMENDMENT PROPOSED

By Mr. Gray:

"Sub-section 58. For the purchase of a tract of land and the construction of a high school building thereupon, and towards the maintenance thereof of any money remaining thereout after the construction of such building at La Plata, Charles county, Maryland, five thousand dolfor that purpose they are hereby granted the same powers lars; said money to be paid to L. Allison Wilmer, Thomas R. Farrell, Samuel C. Padgett, J. Benjamin Mattingly and Benjamin M. Edelen; who are hereby constituted trustees for said school, and made and constituted a body corporate, for the purposes thereof, with power to fill vacancies occurring among their own number, by death, resignation or otherwise, and to have perpetual succession, with powers generally of a corporate body, so far as the same may be necessary for the purposes for which they are named

"And it is further provided, that if the said trustees cannot purchase a tract of land suitable for the purposes, that they may acquire the same by condemnation, and as are possessed by the Board of County School Commissioners of Charles county."
