peal and re-enact with additions and amendments, sections 39, 40, 41, 45, 49, 53, 56, 58 and 59, of Article 43, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Health,' sub-title 'Practitioners of Medicine,' and to repeal all laws or parts of laws in conflict or inconsistent with this Act, and to add additional sections thereto, to be designated as 'Sections 39, 40, 41, 45, 49, 53, 56, 58 and 59.'"
