

Senate bill No. 73, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact with amendments, section 9 A, of Article 10, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Attorney-at-Law and Attorneys-in-Fact,' as added thereto by the Acts of 1898, chapter 166."
