

The Governor shall, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, at each biennial session of the General Assembly hereafter, appoint one person from each county of this State, except the counties of Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick and Washington, and for each of said excepted counties, two persons to be members of the Board of County School Commissioners of their respective counties, and to succeed the members of said respective boards whose terms expire on the first day of May, following such appointments; and in all cases of vacancies in said boards, however caused, the Governor shall fill such vacancies by appointments, to hold for the remainder of the term of the appointee's predecessors, subject to confirmation by the Senate at its next session, and in such appointments, the Governor shall always so provide that one-third of the persons composing said respective boards, shall, at the time of their respective appointments, belong to, or represent the dominant political party other than to which the Governor himself belongs.
