FURTHER AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

By Mr. Williams, of Harford,

Amend section 1, as follows:

Strike out all after the figure "6," in line 4 of printed bill and insert as follows:

"The Board of County School Commissioners of each county, shall be composed of three persons appointed by the Judges of the Circuit Courts of the respective counties, to serve for two years from the first day of August next succeeding their appointment, and until their successors shall qualify; provided, that in counties having over one hundred schools, five persons shall be appointed; any of said commissioners may be removed by the said Judges for incompetency, neglect of duty, or misconduct."
