Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Moore, from the Committee on Corporation, reported favorably,

House bill No. 2, entitled "An Act to amend an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session 1898, chapter 259, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the 'Real Estate Trust Company' so that the corporate title of said corporation shall hereafter be Colonial Trust Company."

Which was read the second time.
