## NEGATIVE-None.

Mr. Bouic, from Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill No. 101, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 69, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Officers,' to follow section 11, and to be known as 'Section 12.'"

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend by striking out "1 per cent.," on lines 10 and 11 of section 1 of printed bill, and insert in lieu thereof the words "one-half of one per cent."

Which proposed amendment was adopted and the bill was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
