Mr. Bouic, from Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably,

Senate bill No. 60, entitled "An Act to legalize the Supplement to the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, containing the General Laws passed at the Sessions of the General Assembly of 1890, 1892, 1894, 1896 and 1898, as codified, printed and published by John Prentiss Poe, and to make the same evidence in the Courts of this State, and before all the Justices of the Peace of this State, and all public officials of this State."
