The President distributed the following message from the House of Delegates:

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 8, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Harford county."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, to change the grade of the public road in the thirteenth district of said county, commonly known as the 'Washington Turnpike Road,' at and near the place where the same crosses the Baltimore and Potomac Railroad at grade, for the purpose of doing away with such grade crossing, and to provide for the construction of the bridge or bridges that may be made necessary thereby."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."
