Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the appointment of a Justice of the Peace, who shall have jurisdiction in and for the town of Takoma Park."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the word "park" in the caption and insert: "Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint a Justice of the Peace of the town of Takoma Park situate partly in Montgomery and Prince George's counties, whose jurisdiction shall be confined to the limits of said town."

Section 2. And be it enacted, that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
