Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Williams, of Harford, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 615 of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to amend Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Harford County,' by adding additional sections thereto."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Betts, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport, in Washington county, to redeem each and all of the bonds issned by them under the provisions of chapter 27, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January session A. D. 1898, and to issue new bonds in lieu thereof."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Betts moved that the rules be suspended and the bill be put upon its third reading and final passage.
