"Section 4. And be it further enacted, that all the operations and acts heretofore undertaken or done and performed in the name of The Old Line Real Estate and Trust Company of Baltimore city, be and the same are hereby ratified and confirmed and made valid in law as the corporate acts of The Old Line Real Estate and Trust Company of Baltimore city, and as such valid operations and acts shall devolve upon and enure to the Central Real Estate and Trust Company of Maryland, which is hereby fixed and established as the corporate name of said corporation."

Which proposed amendments were severally adopted, and the bill

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
