A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 196 to 209, inclusive, of Article 1, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Alleghany County,' sub-title 'Mine Inspector,' and also, to repeal sections 150 to 164, inclusive, of Article 12, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Garrett County,' sub-title 'Manufacturers and Mines,'" for the appointment of mine inspector for Alleghany and Garrett counties, and regulation of coal mines in said counties, and to re-enact them with amendments, and to add certain new sections to said respective Articles to follow in the first mentioned Article, section 209, to be designated as 'Sections 209 A, 209 B, 209 C and 209 D,' and to follow in the second mentioned Article, 'Section 16 H,' to be designated as 'Sections 164 A, 164 B. and 164 C.'"
