REPORT OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Brewington, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 132, of Article 23, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title Salisbury,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add an additional section to follow after section 132, and to be known as "Section 132 A," and read as follows:

"All male qualified voters resident in the annexed territory herein provided for shall be entitled to vote at the next municipal election, provided they were qualified voters at the last general Congressional election, and have resided in said annexed territory or corporate limits of Salisbury for six months prior to said municipal election."
