The following Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, originating in the Senate, were sealed with the Great Seal, and presented on the 26th day of February at 4.30 o'clock, P. M., to the Governor of Maryland for his approval.

“An Act to make valid deeds, mortgages, bonds of conveyance and bills of sale defective in the acknowledgment or in the certificates thereof.”

“An Act to repeal section 164, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title ‘City of Baltimore,’ the subject of said section relating to the imposition of State taxes by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore; and to provide for the imposition and collection of said taxes by said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.”

“An Act to repeal section 3, of chapter 497, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session of 1898, entitled ‘An Act to authorize and direct the County Com-
