Amend title by striking out all after the word "numbered" on the third line, and inserting "Sections 96 A and 96 B, and to follow section 96."

Amend section 1 by striking out the words "a new section" on line 1, and inserting "two new sections."

Amend section 1, line 2, by striking out the word "is," and inserting the word "are."

Amend section 1, line 4, by striking out the words "Section 96 A," and inserting "Sections 96 A and 96 B."
