Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to aid the free beds for the McComas Sanitarium of Garrett county, Maryland."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. Dennis,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal all existing laws for Somerset county, relating to wild fowl and game birds and animals, and to enact the following in lieu thereof, for the better protection and preservation of the same."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Dennis, Messick and Wilkinson.

By Mr. Williams, of Harford,

A bill entitled "An Act to add certain new sections to the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Public Education,' under the new sub-title 'Expenditures for Higher Education,' to follow section 123, to be known as 'Sections 124, 125 and 126.'"

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to amend section 3, Article 1, of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Constitutional Amendments.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 2, Article 87, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Sheriff' sub-title 'Oaths of Office and Bonds,' as the same was repealed and re-enacted by chapter 647 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1894"
