House bill entitled "An Act to transfer to the Cherry Hill, Elkton and Chesapeake City Electric Railway Company of Cecil county, the sum of \$58,000, which by the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, of 1854, chapter 85, was appropriated and transferred to the Elkton and Middletown Railroad Company of Cecil county, and Elkton and Southern Railroad Company, in certain contingencies."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal the 144th section of Article 7, of Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, relating to the town of Taneytown, in Carroll county, and to re-enact the same within an amended or different form."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Governor of Maryland to appoint a notary public for the town of Myersville, in Frederick county, Maryland."

House bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Roads,' to follow section 176, and to be designated as 'Section 176 A.'"
