AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In the first line of the title of original bill, strike out the words "and direct."

In the second line of the title of the original bill, between the words "county" and "to," insert the words "at their discretion."

In the third line of section 1, strike out the word "shall," and insert the words "may at their discretion."

Which proposed amendments were severally adopted, and

The bill was read the second time.
