A bill entitled an Act to make valid deeds, mortgages, bonds of conveyance and bills of sale, defective in the acknowledgment or in certificate thereof.

By Mr. Rohrbach.

A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act passed at the January session, 1894, chapter 562, entitled "An Act to change the name and amend the charter of the Asylum and Training School for the Feeble Minded of the State of Maryland, incorporated by the General Assembly of Maryland, at its session of 1888, chapter 183," and to appropriate a sum of money for the benefit of the Maryland Asylum and Training School for Feeble Minded.
